Graduating students are also eligible for applying to the catalogue, whether their work is in the exhibition or not. ***Please note that you must fill out a separate form for the Graduation Catalogue.** Both of these opportunities are professional development opportunities which can become part of your CV.

- Submit 2-3 pieces for consideration. Up to 3 images per piece.
- Only 1 work will be selected per student, so please rank your preferences.
- Files may be JPG, TIFF or PSD format.
- Files should be a max of 150 dpi. Please label your attached images as follows:

- Works in progress may be considered, but they must be accompanied by a clear written proposal with diagrams, proposed medium, size and installation requirements. We may request a studio visit to get clarifications and check up on your progress.
